

First meeting was held in July 2018(1st Meeting)

PLAN OF ACTION:-

1. Keeping in view the need of the hour it was decided in meeting to introduce vocational courses. In the session 2018-19 two new courses were introduced: B.voc Graphic & Animation, B.Voc. Banking, Insurance & Retailing to prepare students for employment. Keeping in view the demand of students in this area, was also decided to introduce new graduate course in commerce.B.Com was introduced in this session 2018-19.
2. It was also planned that more MOU's will be signed with industry partners who will assist in our vocational programs for training and placement of students.

New MOU's were signed with:

- i. More, Sunami gate, Near Roxy Cinema ,Sangrur
 - ii. Punjab & Sind Bank, Sibia Street, Sangrur.
 - iii. New Insurance Company Ltd., Near Govt Ranbir College, Sangrur.
3. Keeping in view the requirements of B.VOC and B.Com students it was also decided to renovate B.VOC. Block.
Construction work at Multimedia Studio and retail lab was started and all the rooms were renovated.
 4. Need was felt to strengthen the Alumni association of the college.

Alumni meet was held in October, 2018-19. They also provided suggestions to the college to strengthen its policies.

IIInd IQAC meeting was held in November 2018 (Meeting 2)

PLAN OF ACTION:

1. In order to introduce some administrative reforms it was decided in IQAC meeting to shift administrative branch in newly renovated room. The process of shifting administrative branch to renovated room was also completed.
2. In order to give more financial support to needy and deserving students, need was felt to collect more donations from outside sources.

In Session 2018-19 college received extra donation from:

3. The demand for the renovation of staff room was also considered in the meeting. In session 2018-19 Staff room was shifted to newly renovated room.

It was also decided that for proper transparency in financial accounts, internal administrative audit should be done every year.

So for this purpose, all financial Accounts were also checked by Chartered Accountant.

4. A proposal is made to adopt the 'Shahi Samadhan' a heritage site in sangrur. This is to sensitize and encourage our students to take care of their heritage.

Third Meeting was held in March 2019

1. Need was felt to encourage and sensitize students regarding community development programmes.

Students participation was increased in community development Programme students participated in “Beti Bachao Beti Padhao”, “Clean India Campaign” and awareness rallies. They also spent time with Special children and senior citizens at pingalwara, helped underprivileged students. Students also highlighted issues like drug Abuse, Female foeticide, Environment degradation, Personal Hygiene, AIDS and Breast Cancer Awareness.

2. It was decided that Students will be encouraged to participate in various social awareness programmes and to preserve their rich heritage.

Shahi Smadhan was adopted by college students. Students also participated in heritage and literary festival at sangrur. Environment, Drug Abuse and cancer Awareness rallies were also organized by college students blood donation camp was also programmed.

3. It was also decided to renovate seminar hall and construct new toilets for students as well as for the staff.

Construction of open air theatre was also planned.

4. Library will be developed in terms of adding books magazines and e-resources. To enhance the information, literary and learning skills of students, latest edition reference/ text books and journals to be provided in college library.
5. Staff members will be motivated to undertake research work and to participate in national and international seminars.

Six teachers in staff have enrolled for Ph.D.and doing research work. Besides this teachers are also attending national and international seminars refresher courses/ workshops.
